## Terms of Sales

### 1-Registration

The training courses offered by **Stages en Chine** : [www.pratique-arts-chinois.com](http://www.pratique-arts-chinois.com) are open to any adult person and in good health.

#### 1.1-The steps of your registration

1. read our general terms and conditions
2. complete the registration form and send it back to us by e-mail + scan of your passport
3. transfer the down payment

The registration is final as soon as we confirm receipt of the complete registration file and deposit. By submitting your completed registration form, you accept the terms of our general conditions.

### 2-Price

#### 2.1-The price of the course includes:

- the transfers in Yunnan from one site to another (by mini bus or bus)
- the accommodation in a twin room (single room → supplement)
- the meals (the drink included in the meal is tea)
- the bottles of water during physical practice
- the courses
- the translation
- Entrance fees to the visited sites

#### 2.2-The price of the course does not include :

- the flight ticket
- the visa fee
- bank charges related to transfers to China

### 3-Sponsorship

To benefit from our sponsorship, you must register a group of at least 16 people (including yourself) for the same course. You will thus benefit from free participation in the course (remain at your expense: the plane ticket and visa fees). In return, we ask for an exchange of links from our respective websites and some advertising on your website.

### **3-Payment terms**

The payment of the courses is made in two installments, by transfer in Euros on the bank account of **Stages en Chine** : [www.pratique-arts-chinois.com](http://www.pratique-arts-chinois.com). We give you our bank details with your registration file.

- **1<sup>st</sup> transfer** : 50% of the total price at reception of the completed booking forms
- **2nd transfer** : remaining 50% of the total price, one month before departure to China

#### **3.1-Transfer fees not included, at the expense of each participant**

**Stages en Chine** : [www.pratique-arts-chinois.com](http://www.pratique-arts-chinois.com) does not support transfer fees, it will be necessary to add these fees to the price of the course.

### **4-Cancellation and refund**

In case of cancellation on your part, **from 3 months before the course**, we charge a cancellation fee on the deposit you paid us during your registration. The transfer fees generated on our side by this refund will be at your expense.

| If cancellation from <b>3 months</b> before the start of the course : → | <b>10%</b> of the down payment + transfer fees |
| If cancellation from <b>2 months</b> before the start of the course : → | <b>20%</b> of the down payment + transfer fees |
| If cancellation from <b>1 month</b> before the start of the course : →  | <b>30%</b> of the down payment + transfer fees |

If you cancel **before** the last 3 months before the start of the course, we will refund your deposit. We only retain the transfer fees generated from our side to make this refund.

If the trainee changes the duration of his / her stay (advanced departure) or doesn't participate in certain activities during the course, we will not refund.

### **5-Airline ticket**

**Stages en Chine** : [www.pratique-arts-chinois.com](http://www.pratique-arts-chinois.com) does not offer plane tickets. Each participant must personally book his round trip ticket. The destination is **Kunming International Airport in Yunnan Province**.

We welcome our trainees in the arrival hall of Kunming International Airport (for the trek : **Lijiang domestic airport** and for the retreat in a buddhist monastery : **Dali's domestic airport or railway station**) on the first day of the training course. The appointment time will be fixed in advance according to the arrival times of the trainees.

### **6-Course dates**

The first day of training course is the day we receive the group at Kunming Airport. The last day of the training course is the day we accompany you to Kunming Airport.

Example: Training course from March 7th to 21st

Take off on March 6th from your country. You will arrive in China on March 7th.

Take off on March 21st from Kunming. You will land on March 22 in your country.

## **7-Visa**

Since May 10, 2019, the visa application must be made online on the website of the visa centers for China. All applicants are required to come personally to the Visa Center closest to their home, with an appointment, because it is now mandatory to affix fingerprints to complete his file.

We support our interns throughout this important process. We send everyone all the information they need to correctly fill out the visa application form and the documents to be attached to the application file.

## **8-International Insurance**

During your stay in China, you must be covered by an international insurance, which you will need to add to your visa application file. International insurance covers medical care and repatriation during the stay in China. There are different ways to subscribe to this insurance:

- ask your insurer. Some contracts include insurance when traveling abroad;
- when booking your airline tickets by a travel agency, it will offer international insurance;
- **the easiest way:** take advantage of the insurance linked to your international credit card (Visa, Master Card, American Express, Diners Club, JCB) with which you bought your plane ticket: repatriation, medical expenses , luggage theft, etc. (depends on your contract).

**You will receive your insurance certificate by e-mail. This service is free.**

## **9-Health - vaccine**

Before Covid-19: No vaccine was mandatory. You had to be up to date with the booster shots (tetanus). Post Covid-19 situation: We will update this section as soon as we have more information.

In the registration file, you will find a “mini” medical form to fill out regarding your possible allergies.

We also require you to give us a medical certificate testifying of your aptitude to physical exercise at an average altitude of 2000 meters. Validity date: less than one month before the departure date.

## **10-Responsibilities**
